The 2025 “**Running Into the Future**” Session will be held June 11-15, 2025, at the DoubleTree by Hilton in Lawrence, KS. 200 McDonald Drive, Lawrence, KS 66044. All Grand Session registration forms, fees, housing forms, and contest entry forms are due no later than May 1, 2025.

REGISTRATION: Everyone attending Grand Session 2025 must register even if only attending one day. Session documentation will be completed and emailed to Pam Henderson. If you have any questions, please contact Session Chairs: Pam Henderson (henderson_pk@yahoo.com) or Stephanie McNatt (mcnattstephanie@yahoo.com). Any person who is an Executive Member of a Bethel Guardian Council, Past Bethel Guardian, or Past Associate Bethel Guardian should register as a voting delegate. Session payments should be made payable to Grand Session.

VIRTUAL REGISTRATION: Members who cannot attend Grand Session in person but still want to register for the Grand Bethel drawing, for appointed floor officers and representatives may do so by paying the Daughter registration fee of \$30. This will allow the Member to join the Zoom session on Friday night for the GB meeting, Saturday afternoon for the GB Installation practice and the Grand Bethel Installation on Saturday night. Those Members who wish to be in the drawing for the Grand Bethel line officers must be present for the Installation practice and ceremony on Saturday.

LATE FEE: If payment and/or registration forms are not postmarked and/or time stamped by the deadline of May 1, 2025, the late fee of \$20 must be included. This fee will be strictly enforced. There will be NO late fee charged for any Daughter that is registered within seven days following her Membership Ceremony.

VISITORS: Everyone attending any event or activity at the 2025 Grand Session must register by paying the appropriate fee.

NAME TAGS: The 2025 name tag must always be worn when outside your assigned rooms, except for competitions. We would also ask that an adult hold the girls’ name tags during Formal Opening, the Grand Bethel meeting and those participating in the Installations.

HOUSING FEES: Just a reminder that all fees are due by the May 1st deadline. The only exception to this rule is a Daughter that become members late in the term and those paying the late fee.

HOTEL CHECK IN: The Bethel Guardian or her Representative will have room keys distributed to her/him after 3pm by the Session Chairs. Please come to the CONVENTION area (at rear of hotel) entry doors to check in upon arrival. If you are arriving after Wednesday, please contact one of the Session Chairs for your room assignment and keys. Do not go to the front desk at any time throughout the week.

JOB'S DAUGHTER HOUR: Job's Daughter Hour will be held on Wednesday evening with Vice Grand Guardian Tish and Vice Associate Grand Guardian Tim. All Daughters are expected to attend. Please make sure your girls are present and on time.

GB REGISTRATION: Daughters that plan to register for the 2025-2026 drawing at the Grand Bethel meeting must register at the GB registration desk during one of the three registration periods listed in the Session Program. Because the Grand Session packet was published and distributed later than normal and the merging of Kansas and Oklahoma, we will not require those registering to be in attendance the entire time of Grand Session. The current Grand Bethel Officers and Representatives need to attend the Formal Opening practice.

VOTING DELEGATES: Voting delegates should pick up their credentials from the table prior to the 8:00 am start of the Business session on Thursday. The 2025 adult membership will be awarded to the Bethel with the most voting delegates in the room at roll call on Friday. Remember the business meeting starts at 8:30 am on Friday!! Please see the schedule to know when the credentials table will be open.

GGC COMMITTEE CHAIRS: Please be prepared to give your report when called upon during the business session. Three typed copies of your report are to be turned into the Grand Secretary at the business meetings on Thursday and Friday. You may also email the report to her.

HOTEL ROOMS: The hotel has been instructed on who is allowed to come to the front desk. Please let your Daughters and adults know NOT to go to the front desk for any reason. If you need something or have a problem, please contact Stephanie McNatt at .816.206.0154 or Pam at 913.306.3087. This rule pertains to both adults and Daughters.

GRAND SESSION RULES & REGULATIONS

As Job's Daughters we will be in the spotlight during Grand Session. All of us need to conduct ourselves according both with our actions and our attire. Please make sure you follow the dress code set by the Grand Guardian. Daughters and Adults are expected to exemplify the ideal public image to ensure the highest representation of Job's Daughters.

Any active member of Job's Daughters caught using tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal drugs while in attendance at Grand Session will be sent/taken home immediately.

CHAPERONES: Just a reminder that all Daughters under the age of 20 must be chaperoned during the entire session. There must be one CAV adult for every five girls. No Daughter is to leave or go outside the hotel without a CAV chaperone. Chaperones should be aware of their responsibility and the importance of their role in overseeing the safety of the Daughters in their care. Daughters who have turned 20 but are still in a role as a Daughter must follow the same rules through the completion of Grand Session. Daughters may go to competitions, meeting or meals in groups of two or more without an adult escorting them if they do not go outside the building.

CELL PHONES: Cell phones may not be used during official events or business meetings of Grand Session by adults or Daughters. If for some reason (emergency) the adults need to be on their phone, please make sure it is on silent.

FOOD DELIVERIES: Any food your Bethel has delivered must be delivered in the hotel lobby. Only an adult may meet the delivery person.

SWIMMING POOL: A reminder, if your Members are going to the pool the same rule applies: one CAV adult per five girls at the pool. There is no lifeguard on duty. Cover ups, (NOT TOWELS) are to be worn to and from the pool, no matter where your room is. No bikinis allowed.

HOTEL ROOMS: Please remember this is a public hotel and we are not the only guests here. Hallway conversations should be kept to a minimum. Make sure the doors are not propped open and when the lights are on the curtains must be closed.

Under no circumstances should anyone leave a mess for the hotel staff to clean up. Bethel Guardians, please make sure you walk through all your rooms, so you know they are in good condition when you arrive and before you leave. Any unnecessary cleanup will be billed to the Bethel responsible for the mess or damage.

DRESS CODE

FORMAL ATTIRE

Ladies: knee length or longer formals, gowns or “dressy” dresses or palazzo style pants. Appropriately fitted strapless, halter, one shoulder, and spaghetti straps are acceptable. At no time should any undergarments be showing. shoes, strapless gowns are acceptable.
Men: tuxedo, suits or sport coat and tie

SEMI-FORMAL ATTIRE

Ladies: dresses or skirts and blouses with appropriate footwear

MEETING ATTIRE

Ladies: knee length or longer dresses/skirts or dress pants. All tops should be in good taste with no lunging necklines.
Men: dress pants or slacks and collared shirt/polo

CASUAL ATTIRE

Jeans, khaki, shorts, athletic pants, casual shirts, polos, or t-shirts

POOL ATTIRE

No string or thong suits or speedos. All swimwear must fit appropriately. Cover-ups and footwear must be worn going to and from the pool area.

DON'T

Wear items too low or high cut, no cleavage or thighs exposed, midribs showing are not appropriate or acceptable. Bra straps CANNOT show.

DO

Dresses/skirts are to be no shorter than 3” above the knee. Shorts must be fingertip length or longer. Wear event appropriate footwear. Make sure garments fit well (no tugging, pulling, pushing, or readjusting)

These guidelines are for DAUGHTERS and ADULTS and must be adhered to. If anyone does not follow the dress code, their BETHEL GUARDIAN and/or the GRAND GUARDIAN will address this matter immediately.

Housing reservations for 2025 “Running Into the Future” Session are to be made online using your Bethel’s online registration forms. Room reservations must be made no later than May 1, 2025.
